## Things to keep in mind:

- During the reading of the Six Psalms, there is no movement, sitting, or talking (by anyone but the reader). The Sign of the Cross is not made.
- A total of no more than fourteen verses (including irmoi, troparia, and theotokia) are included in each ode of the canons.
- At the Eighth Ode of the Canon, rather than "Glory to the Father..." we say "Let us bless Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, the Lord."
- For Simple and Doxology service: Katavasia (i.e. the irmos of the last canon) after third, sixth, eighth, and ninth odes.
- For Polyeleos and higher: Seasonal katavasia after every ode.
- Aposticha only in Daily Matins.
